6 Tips to Help Safeguard Consumer Data: Know before you disclose – Never respond to text messages, emails or phone calls from companies alleging to be your bank, government officials or business representatives that request your banking ID, account numbers, username or password. A good offense is the best defense – Make sure your system is running the latest security software, web browser and operating system to defend against viruses, malware and other online threats. Connect with caution – Sensitive information should only be sent over websites with <https://> in the URL because these sites encrypt transmissions. Lock it up tight – Combine capital and lowercase letters with numbers and symbols to create a more secure password, and update it. Own your online presence – Value and protect your personal information, particularly your date of birth and SSN. Help take a bite out of crime – Report stolen finances or identities and other cybercrime to the Internet Crime Complaint Center (ic3.gov).
